

VICEROY DECREE VIRTUAL INSTITUTE Scholarship Program

The Virtual Institutes for Cyber and Electromagnetic Spectrum Research and Employ (VICEROY) DoD Electromagnetic and Cyber Research and Experiential Education Virtual Institute (DECREE) is a consortium of five universities created in close collaboration with the Department of Defense (DoD) and Defense Information Base partners to address recruitment and training challenges faced in DoD-related cyber and Electromagnetic Spectrum (EMS) fields. The goal of the program is to grow the availability of well-qualified and trained students with essential knowledge, skills, and abilities required to plan, synchronize, and lead DoD-related cyber and EMS operations.

Scholars participating in the Virtual Institute program are eligible to receive a scholarship of up to \$10,000, subject to the fulfillment of all program activities and responsibilities. The scholarship amount is contingent upon the funding provided by the Griffiss Institute and may be adjusted or discontinued if such funding is reduced or terminated.

Eligibility Criteria:

VICEROY DECREE scholarships will be awarded to students selected by their home institution's scholarship committee. Applicant must:

- 1. Be a current full-time sophomore or junior
- 2. Be enrolled in one of the following home institution programs: Computer Science, Cybersecurity, Computer Engineering, Data Science, Criminology, or any other Viceroy related fields
- 3. Be security clearance eligible (generally, U.S. citizenship is a standard requirement for security clearances)
- 4. Intend to pursue employment within DoD or the defense industry

Expectations of scholars:

- Complete VI courses
- Meet regularly with their DECREE VI mentors (bi-weekly)
- Participate in DECREE Seminars and Events (monthly)
- Participate in program evaluation activities (quarterly)
- Complete practical offensive security training (annually)
- Participate in the annual VI engagement symposia (annually)
- Complete professional certifications (annually)

Application Components:

- 1. Letter of Recommendation from a Professor, Supervisor, or Commander that can speak to your skills and potential in DoD-related cybersecurity and electromagnetic spectrum operations
- 2. Short essay responses
- 3. Resume that includes any academic honors, awards, community service activities, athletics, military/ROTC service, extracurricular activities, and/or leadership positions held, if applicable.
- 4. Transcript (unofficial is acceptable)
- 5. Signed and dated application form
